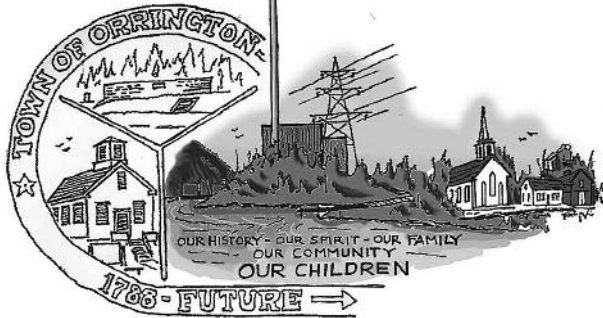

**Meet the Terminator at PERC's Annual Open House**

No, not the Arnold Schwarzenegger character, but something equally as formidable – PERC's Komptech 6000s slow-speed grinder, also known as the Terminator.

Actually, PERC now has two of these impressive machines which can grind up all kinds of waste for use as fuel in its waste to energy plant – including lots of material that normally goes to landfills.

You can see the Terminator in action and much more on Saturday, July 21, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. when PERC holds its **annual Open House** as part of Old Home Week.

As in past years, there will be educational displays, a "touch-a-truck" area featuring heavy equipment, trucks, and public safety vehicles, and special games for the kids.

New this year will be a **yard sale**, with all money received being matched by PERC and donated to a local charity, and freshly **grilled hot dogs and hamburgers**.

Visitors 18 and older can **take a tour** of the PERC plant as long as they are wearing closed-toe shoes.

The PERC plant, located at 29 Industrial Way and River Road, serves more than 40 Maine towns and cities, as well as commercial waste haulers from throughout the region, taking their waste and turning it into renewable power.

PERC plays an important role in Maine's solid waste management hierarchy, keeping waste out of our landfills by reducing it by 90% in volume and processing it as fuel to generate electricity. PERC's commitment to the environment has earned it awards from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and Maine Department of Environmental Protection.

PERC owners are continuing to make important new investments to make its operations more efficient, and

its skilled and dedicated employees are always finding for ways to recover more metals and other recyclables and process more materials, such as carpet and bulky wastes, that historically goes to landfills.

For the men and women of Orrington's PERC plant, it's all about making sure that the right waste gets to the right place in the most efficient, affordable, and environmentally friendly manner. Stop by the open house and learn more about how they do it.

**Cool Conservation Commission Contest**

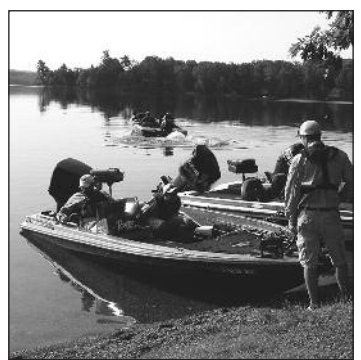
The Orrington Conservation Commission (OCC) will be sponsoring a cool new contest during Old Home Week.

To enter, contestants must visit any or all of the five properties the Commission oversees and retrieve a code posted at each property. Each code shall be taken to the Orrington Public Library to obtain one entry into the contest. Contestants who take photographs of themselves and upload them to the Orrington Conservation Commission facebook page will receive additional entries. Prizes will be awarded!

Explore these wonderful natural resources we have in our own backyard. The five properties to visit are:

**1. Brewer Lake Boat Launch.** This easy to use launch area is located on Brewer Lake Road and has plenty of parking across the road.

**2. Fox Island.** This island is just a short paddle across Brewer Lake from the boat launch. Half the island is private. Watch for signs marking the "Day Use" picnic area and please remember to sign in as required by the State of Maine, no

fires and carry out your trash.

**3. The Sedgunkedunk Fishway** This recently rebuilt site is located on Brewer Lake Road near Bob's Kozy Korner store. The picnic area has a covered picnic table, walking trail along

the stream and a convenient hand-carry boat launch that is perfect for kayakers.

**4. The Picnic area.** This lovely grass and shaded area on the bank of the Penobscot River is located off Route 15 about one mile south of Center Drive. Open from Memorial Day through October, there are picnic tables at both upper and lower levels which offer beautiful views of the Penobscot River.

**5. Olin Richardson Tract on Kings' Mountain.** This beautiful 106 acre preserve has a parking area and picnic tables. Stop for lunch, sled in the winter or follow the trails and discover a variety of natural habitats.
